

PASSION-FLOWER NECKLACE

DESIGN BY PATRICIA WILLIAMS

A LUSH CIRCLE OF DAINTY, PICOT-TIPPED PENDANTS SET OFF WITH SWEET LITTLE FLOWERS AT THE JOININGS CREATES A STRIKING FLORAL NECKLACE THAT WILL PERFECTLY ACCESSORIZE A VARIETY OF SPRING FASHIONS.

SKILL LEVEL  EASY

FINISHED SIZE

One size fits most

MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton (300 yds per ball):
1 ball each #995 ocean and #949 light pastels
- Size 6/1.80mm steel crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Jump clasp

GAUGE

Is not important for this item.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Picot: Ch 3, sl st in top of last st.

Cluster (cl): Holding back last lp of each st on hook, 3 dc in place indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

NECKLACE

Row 1: With ocean, ch 219, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. (218 sc)

Row 2: Sk first 17 sc, join with sc in next sc, [ch 11, sk next 2 sc, sc in each of next 5 sc] 26 times, ch 11, sk next 2 sc, sc in next sc, leaving rem sts unworked, turn.



Row 3: Ch 2, [(5 dc, 3 tr, **picot**—see *Special Stitches*, 3 tr, 5 dc) in next ch sp, sk next 2 sc, sc in next sc] across to last ch sp, (5 dc, 3 tr, picot, 3 tr, 5 dc) in last ch sp. Fasten off.

**Petal
Make 28.**

With light pastel, ch 3, sl st in first ch to

form ring, sc in ring, [(ch 3, **cl**—see *Special Stitches*, ch 3, sc) in ring] 3 times, ch 3, cl in ring, ch 3, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

Sew Petals to Necklace as shown in photo.

Attach jump clasp to ends. **C!**
